The East Baton Rouge Council on Aging, in partnership with Senator Cleo Fields (Cleo Cares), is taking care of the seniors of EBR Parish this Thanksgiving with a Turkey Giveaway. On Thursday, November 19th, they are hosting a Thanksgiving Turkey Giveaway (while supplies last) at 10:00 a.m. at The Lotus Center located at 1701 Main Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70802. There will be an 18-Wheeler stuffed with frozen turkeys just in time for your Thanksgiving dinner! The giveaway is open to all seniors 60 years old or older who reside in East Baton Rouge Parish. Seniors must be prepared to present an ID as proof of residency.

Hot Thanksgiving Dinner

On Monday, November 23rd and Tuesday, November 24th, EBRCOA homebound seniors will receive a complete hot Thanksgiving Dinner delivered to their door. The dinner includes gumbo, an entrée and a dessert! To be eligible for the hot Thanksgiving Dinner, seniors must be an active recipient of their Meals on Wheels Program as of November 1, 2020.
