Senior COVID-19 Drive-Thru Testing Day

BATON ROUGE, Louisiana (01/26/2022) – The East Baton Rouge Council on Aging, in conjunction with Senator Cleo Fields and the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), is hosting a Senior COVID-19 Drive-Thru Testing Day on Saturday, January 29, 2022 from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM at the Louisiana Leadership Institute located at 5763 Hooper Road, Baton Rouge, LA 70811.

Senior centers will transition from drive-thru meal service to an in-person congregate setting on Monday, January 31, 2022. EBRCOA is strongly encouraging seniors to get tested for COVID-19 before reconvening at their respective senior centers for congregate meals. Registration is required using this link: http://www.orion.healthcare/community. Any senior needing assistance to register for a COVID-19 test should call (225) 960-1200. Transportation will also be provided by request through the EBRCOA Lotus Rides at (225) 361-0299. A meal will provided to senior participants, while supplies last.

EBRCOA will have drawings for prizes for participation such as a Magnalite Pot Set, a blender, a television, and an electric fireplace. The senior center with the most participation at the Senior COVID-19 Drive-Thru Testing Day will receive a celebratory party at their center once the centers resume in-person activities.
