## EBRCOA Host a Clinic for Second COVID-19 Booster Shot

**BATON ROUGE, Louisiana (4/11/2022)** – The East Baton Rouge Council on Aging (EBRCOA) is excited to partner with Albertsons Companies to host a Vaccination Clinic for the Second COVID-19 Booster Shot on Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at The Lotus Center (1701 Main Street) from 9:30 A.M. and 6:00 P.M.

The Second Booster shot is available to individuals aged 50 and older who received the first booster shot at least 4 months ago. Both Moderna and Pfizer vaccines will be available.

Participants are required to register for the clinic by completing the consent form located at <https://bit.ly/3j9hNUp>. Seniors who need assistance in completing the registration form can call EBRCOA at 225-923-8000 and staff members are waiting to assist them through the process.

Pre-registration is required. No vaccinations will be provided without an appointment. Proper ID is required to prove residency and age. Seniors must also present their Medicare/Insurance card (the red, white, and blue card) at the time of service.

“We are excited to host another community vaccination event! The EBRCOA is committed to doing our part to eradicate this deadly virus.
